WHEN TO USE THE PHONETIC ALPHABET

- When telling other people names of valves or details from technical drawings;
- When the sender or receiver might misunderstand, such as sound-alike systems, or in high noise areas, or where there is poor radio or telephone reception.

BEST PRACTICE:

- Avoid using phonetic words other than those designated above;
- Always use specific or standard terms, never slang terms.
